Around 250 pupils from approximately 30 secondary schools in Dyfed were involved at the District's Cross Country Championships earlier today in Narberth...as races provided selection for the Welsh Schools National Championships next month.

Held earlier than in previous years, the **Dyfed Secondary Schools Cross Country Championships** was back at a new venue this morning (**Tuesday 22nd January**). Having been staged at Parc Dinefwr in Llandeilo over the last couple of years, the 2019 edition went to the grounds of **Oakwood Theme Park in Narberth** where a decent crowd turned out to support those participating.

All roads for children, supporters and teachers from across Brianne, Pembrokeshire, Llanelli and Ceredigion led to the magnificent park in Narberth for the event.





Schools' Competition comes Thick and Fast...

The majority of the athletes that took part would have finished in the leading positions at the [four respective area championships](#) that all went ahead last week featuring all the schools.

[Pembrokeshire](#) was the first to hold their event at Haverfordwest Racecourse and was followed a few hours later with the [Brianne](#) races at Ammanford Recreation Ground. The [Ceredigion](#) championship got the better weather of all 24 hours later at the Urdd Campus in Llangrannog before [Llanelli](#) schools battled through the wind and rain at the fourth and final event at Pembrey Country Park in the latter stages of last week.

The top 10 in each of the races from Haverfordwest, Ammanford, Llangrannog and Pembrey qualified for the Dyfed final at Oakwood on Tuesday as pupils went head to head with selection places up for grabs at the end.

The venue has already been used to hosting big cross country events, where the Pembrokeshire Primary Schools Cross Country Championships have already been held involving over 1,000 pupils.

Oakwood Theme Park provided a great setting...

During the morning, there were eight races for all categories with each one not only representing their area, but also their school. The Year 7 Girls and Boys, competing in these championships for the first time since moving up from primary level, got the action underway at 11:15am and were followed by events for the combined year 8 and 9, and combined year 10 and 11. A handful of Senior Girls and Senior Boys were also in attendance and went off last at lunchtime.

The course was set up on the field and consisted of a small and large lap, overlooking the many attractions and activities on offer for visitors and families at Oakwood Theme Park.

The weather provided a bit of everything - wind, rain, cloud, hail and a small glimpse of the sun after the risk of snow that was first forecasted earlier last week. The underfoot conditions was in very good condition and it played a big part for fast racing and a number of tactical battles as club teammates and friends went head to head.

The day ran very smoothly thanks to the support from those school teachers and volunteers from Welsh Athletics and Pembrokeshire Harriers who marshalled and volunteered at the start and finish areas and out on the course.

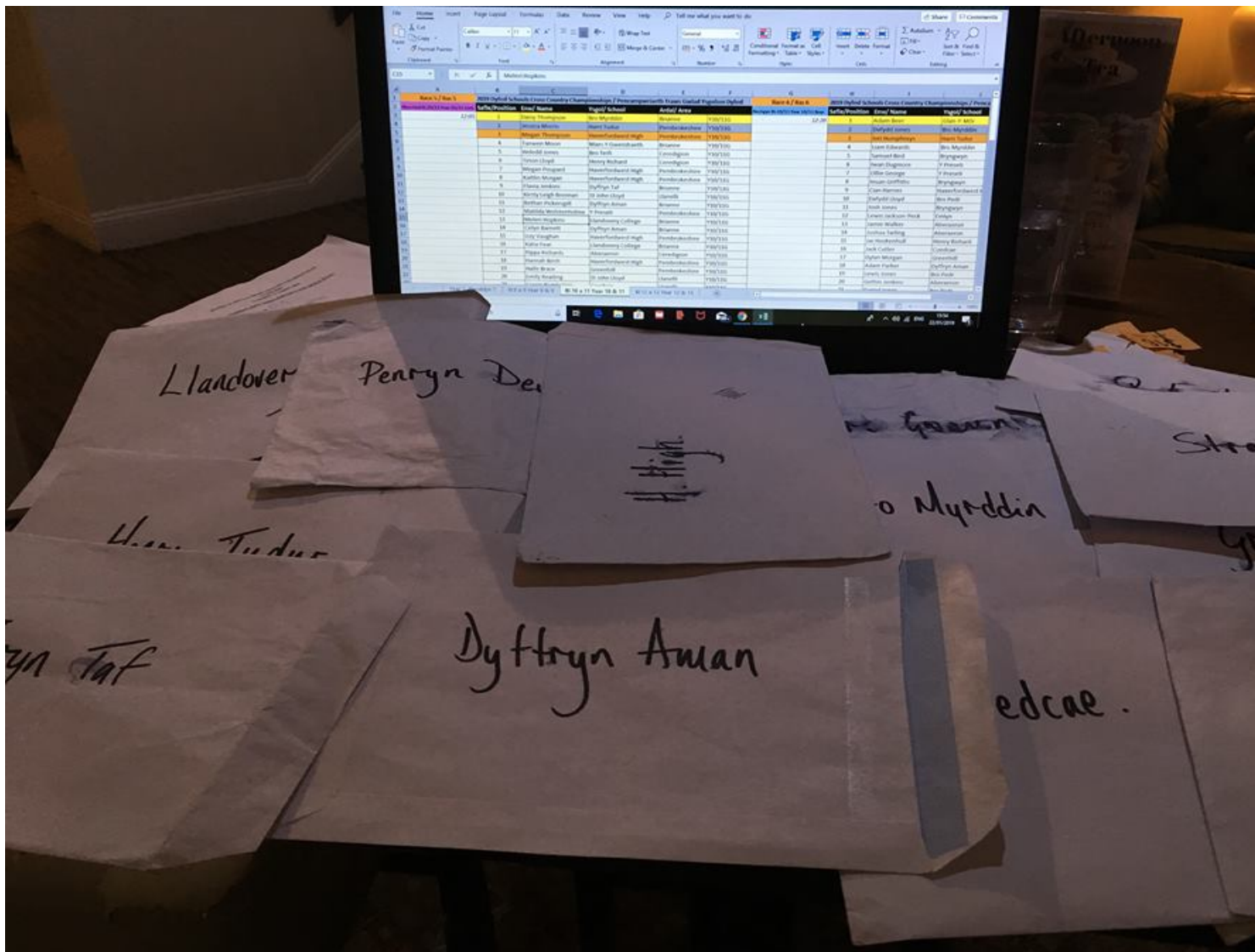
